RFQ DESCRIPTION

The Kouga Wind Farm Community Development Trust (KWFCDT) is inviting qualified service providers to submit quotations for site clearance services as part of the infrastructure development project of building a new primary school for the Kouga Circuit in Humansdorp.


The scope of work includes manual and mechanical clearing of designated areas, safe disposal of vegetation, and adherence to local environmental and safety regulations. Service providers must ensure responsible handling of cleared materials, including community firewood distribution and waste disposal at municipal sites.

Full Site Clearance Scope

- Clearing methods:
 - Manual cutting with hand tools (saws, brush cutters) for smaller areas or delicate vegetation.
 - Mechanical clearing with handheld machinery (chainsaws, etc.)
- Clearing sequence:
 - Removal of large trees or stumps first, followed by smaller vegetation.
 - All cut trees and branches must be taken by hand to a central point outside the boundary
 - From there it must be removed by means of trucks and bakkies to the various communities, where it will be made available to the residents for firewood.
 - Smaller cut branches and leaves must be taken to the local municipal dump site.
- Waste disposal:
 - Plan for the collection, segregation, and disposal of cleared vegetation according to local
 - Potential options include chipping, composting, or removal to a designated waste facility.

Safety Measures:

- SMME's will be responsible for the safety of their teams.
- SMME's will be responsible for their own PPE, such as safety glasses, gloves, hearing protection, high-visibility clothing, sturdy footwear
